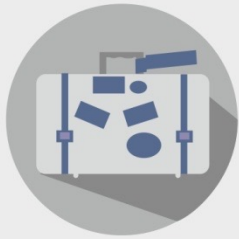

The enterprise IRIDA TOURIST HOTEL ENTERPRISES SINGLE MEMBER PRIVATE COMPANY based in South Aegean region, has joined the Action "Supporting the Establishment and Operation of New SMEs in the tourism sector" with a total budget of **689 million €** (500,6 million € from EPA<sub>n</sub>EK and 188,4 million € from Regional Operational Programmes). The investment's total budget is 399.614,00 € out of which 199.807,00 € is public expenditure. The Action is co-financed by Greece and the European Union - European Regional Development Fund.
