The result defines other ways, exploring new materials, devising self-taught methos of handcrafting, and proposing innovative woven landscapes offering aesthetic, plastic and symbolic annotations and solutions in the process and the endless possibilities of weaving. Using cotton, flax, wick, burlap, wool and silk, wire, textiles, threads, handmade paper and cardboard, jute, sisal, reeds and woods, dyes and rags, they explore, redefine and recreate the timelessness of the art of weaving.








THE ELEMENTS OF THE MYTH OF MYKONS

Everyone should visit Mykonos" bad stated the First Lady of America and the first member of the international jet set ever to visit the island. We all knew it was not going to be the last one. In the next pages the reasons of this success explained one by one. BY IRA SINIBALIA

1. THE CHARISMA OF THE LOCALS

Ever since the early days in the '50s when its first lovers "discovered" its reality, rumors and tall stories have invariably got into a frightful tangle lavishly sprinkled with gold-dust, which is not at all surprising given that people have always held extreme views of Mykonos. Then the island was little more than a village; small and white. The electric company would supply electricity to the island up to midday; water was a luxury, and most houses had water tanks, wells, primus stoves, braziers, coal and storm lamps. "(...) Traveler's first impression is that Mykonos wasn't finally a big deal. A deserted half-finished pier, forgotten by God. The port's dark during the night and earthy during the day, with the meltemi raising clouds of dispersed dust that makes one feel like leaving before you have arrived. (...) Let it be. Maybe someday people would understand that everything in life is a stage effect creating an ambiance; a nice and pleasant ambience holding

you close or a cold ambiance turning you away." These words belong to the Greek pioneer Zachos Chatzifotiou who came to know the island during the early 50's. He was an elegant "settler", a member of the bon viveurs clan of young dudes who invaded the island seeking a remoted and pristine place to be and to live. The Mykonians put up with the fancy crowd, the boys and the girls who were vividly strolling around the island, on its sandy beaches and in its white-washed narrow streets. The locals, as hospitable as can be, let the first visitors into their houses. The morning schedule included a boat ride for a swim to Aghios Stefanos, or for the fitter members, a long walk to Ornos. In the afternoon everyone goes up to Skalaria on foot. This is the very spot where, later on, Makis Zouganelis opened the renowned Remezzo. So there was Mykonos' first "club", Kioukas' Sali Bagli – named after a character in an oriental fairy tale – serving coffee, turkish delight

and stewed sweets. In the evenings, spirits were high and the island's white alleys would ring with the laughter of merrymakers. Melina, Eleni Vlahou, Zahos Chatzifotiou, Dimis Kritsas were just a few of the prime movers who discovered Mykonos and made sure it became known throughout Greece and beyond. Furthermore the whole of high-society Athens went to Mykonos over the next years. But that is only part of the story. Soon Elsa Maxwell organized cruises for stars and the royals.

Some years later, the first «clubs» started tentatively cropping up. Sali Bagli was taken over by Mimis Zouganelis and is renamed Paralos. Rich and glamorous customers excelled one another in beauty, high spirits and good mood. Grace Kelly, sad Princess Sorayia, Melina with Dassin, Jean Moreau with Thodoros Roubanis, Brigitte Bardot, and many others... Yachts are lined up at the port: Niarchos' «Creoli», Papagou-Horn's «Eros», Fix's «Isabella», Karella's «Thentara», Kostas and Heidi Goulandri's «Cinderella».

2. THE CELEBRITIES' FACTOR.

Onassis would often drop the anchor of «Christina» off the coast and have Maria Callas, and later on Jackie Kennedy, taken ashore on speedboat. The former First Lady of America had been to Greece on a state visit in 1961. Jackie had been to see the Acropolis escorted by Amalia Karamanlis, had her picture taken next to the Charioteer at Delphi, and had sailed on a warship up to Mykonos. Her enthusiastic reception by the islanders lined up at the port for her arrival, the white-washed houses, Petros the pelican, who rushed to be photographed by her side, everyone's simplicity

fascinated the star of the Kennedys. She would come back accompanied by her sister Lee Ratzuille. The rest of the jet set would soon follow. Galatis' and Maroulina's clientele would now feature Hollywood stars, princesses from the Orient and stunning beauties from Europe.

Giannis Galatis' house, frequently photographed by the International Press, at Platis Yialos, becomes the setting for legendary parties. A motley assortment of guests - Princes Kressi, Ard Von Krow, Efi Mela, Rika Dialyna, Prince Carl Von Furstenberg, Thomas Fritz, Ann Lomberg, Yehudi Menuhin, Dimitris Vittos, Elli Lampsa are all there. Queen of the island is Anna Veltsou, whose house is a stopover for celebrities arriving at Mykonos. There is dancing at Paralos, with Sobolas playing the guitar and Maria (who would be proprietress of Chez Maria's years later) singing along... It's wild merrymaking! One day Onassis takes a seat at Kostis' café down the road from the Town Hall, favourite hangout of Melpo Axioti, a great Mykonean lady. Further down at Andreas' tavern, Mrs Maria was cooking for John Lennon, Agatha Christie or Werner Von Brown. Once Paul Newman, having enjoyed a delicious meal, picked up a felt tip pen and scribbled on the wall "Paul Newman had a meal here", but Andreas rushed to have it whitewashed because it...spoiled the whiteness of the wall!

As time goes by, the whole of high-society Athens find their way to the island. Eleni Vlahou, Pavlos Vardinogiannis, Dimitris Karellas, Dimis Kritsas, Zahos Hatzifotiou with Jenny Karezi, Aliki, Lola Tsoukatou, Nassos Botsis, Takis Horn, Anna Veltsou and many more everybody's favourites. In those days, a few good people knew about the island. This, however,











has changed and that's what people moan about years later, as they watch tourism assume a completely different form with each passing decade. In 1967, Paralos is taken over by Makis Zouganelis and is dubbed Remezzo. Shortly afterwards, at Yialos, at a building open to the sky which had been a "casino" with "electronic" games of that bygone age, Kostas Zouganelis sets up "9 Muses". With parties going on strong till the morning light, the early discos of the island were here to stay.

3. THE CRAZINESS OF NIGHTLIFE

By the early '70s, Mykonos had been fully conditioned for what was to follow. The road was open, literally, and the remote sandy beaches welcome the first nudists. The first ferries put in at the port. New hotels and shops are mushrooming all over. It is the age of disco and fabulous parties. It is also the age when the new arrivals will give the island its new identity. Pierro Aversa with the first gay bar on the island; Johnnie Reed with Vengera; Billy Bo, Takis Theodorakopoulos, Babis Passaoglou, Vicky Leandros, Zoe Laskari, Angelos Droulias, Erikos Petilon. Among them the Myconean prime movers, like Vassilis Koussathanas, Thodoris Fouskis, the Zouganelis... Pierro Aversa arrives at the island from New York sometime in the middle of the '60s. He is the one who gives Paradise and Super Paradise beaches their names, and opens one of the world's most famous bars, the celebrated Pierro's. Pierro knew almost everyone there was to know, and very soon a whole world of art and entertainment, including in its ranks actors, singers, dancers, artists, designers, fashion models started making their way to Mykonos, gradually lending it

a gay air. Everyone is looking for something new, everyone finds on Mykonos what they are looking for. Absolute freedom... Filippis opens a restaurant in the courtyard of his family house, at La Palma, the small business next to Vengera, Johnnie Reed sells leather sandals and fine pareos, Giannis Klissouras and Litsa Diamanti open Marquis, the second gay bar on the island, and many more soon follow suit. At the beach in Paragka, the first hippies throw full moon parties. Higher society members sail on Fouskis' boat to Elia. Fabulous models laze away in the sun on Psarou's sandy beach. Now the timing of the events has changed its course. Everything begins at night and... ends at night. There is festive chaos at Pierro's steps every night. The number of visitors is on the increase, and Matoyianni, the main street in Chora, shows the first signs of road traffic. This is the brightest period in the history of the island, never to be repeated. Standing out among the visiting celebrities at the time are Princess Ira Von Furstenberg, Elizabeth Taylor, Jeanne Moreau, Jean Seberg. In the early '80s the pace of life remains much the same. Wild all-night revelries, high-society people and gays from all over the world live in a frenzy of dancing, drinking and uninhibited sex. Babis Passaoglou opens Ibiza and, later on, Astra in collaboration with Minas who drew up the designs. Vengera is open for breakfast at about 10.00. After two in the afternoon, beaches are crammed with naked bodies squeezing in a nap under the hot sun before the next wild drinking spree. Every afternoon, on the veranda of Caprice customers scramble for a table with a view of the sun setting over Venice. At Aghios Sostis, still inaccessible even years later, those who want to lose the crowds discover their paradise.

4. BEACH PERFECT

At Psarou's always-high society beach, gentlemen sporting gold watches, ladies in matching beach towels and fresh from the hairdresser's, and children escorted by Philippenese ladies declare themselves locals after their second visit. At Paradise, models compete with one another for seductive looks. Some beaches, like Paragka or Elia, seem to attract the better part of the island's population. For years to come, Panormos will remain a closely guarded secret to all but to those few that remain faithful to the island. The years go by, until «the plague of the century» finally inflicts a deadly blow upon the island, devastating its once crowded beaches.

The island's amorous fame had spread everywhere. Staunch patrons of the '80s and '90s, fashion superstars, like Valentino, Thierry Mugleur and Jean-Paul Gaultier. Hotels are being renovated, rooms to let are being redeveloped, provided with public utility services, assume a distinctive character, they have colour added to them. Beaches are cleaned up, nudists are reduced in number, and gays are forced to be more discreet. Locals recall their Mykonean hospitality, tradition and nobility. The new ring road solves some of the traffic problems, the value of property in certain areas rises, and the first villas of well known businessmen are built. The island is reborn from its ashes, like another phoenix, all within a summer.

5. THE SECRET IS CHANGE

In the '90s the island becomes the favourite resort of a new generation of Greek businessmen and powerful men in other spheres of activity. And this means a lot. Besides, we live in the age of the media. They shape the star system that replaced high society of bygone ages. Publishers, channel directors, contractors and self-made businessmen who, together with some of the old ones like Panos Zinas, Vangelis Tsagaris and Zoe Laskari, are still the core that will push Mykonos back to the top. The party which no one can afford to miss is not Giannis Galatis', but the momentous event of the summer that Lakis Gavalas holds every year.

Matoyiannia is becoming one of the most expensive commercial markets in Greece. Every well-known house, all the maitres, and all the jewelers claim a few square meters of the island's cobbled alleys. The fact is that the quality of life has definitely improved. And it seems that everyone is doing their best. Restaurants employ chefs from Athens; bars boast well-known dj's. And Mykonos is up to greet the new millennium in a festive atmosphere and with a long list of celebrities: Brigitte Nielsen wreaking havoc invading Pierro's toilets, Keith Richards and his wife calling each other names outside Astra, Linda Evangelista drinking juice at Pierro's, Tom Hanks and Steven Spielberg swimming at Elia, Mila Jovovich dancing on the wooden floor at Mad, and Barbara Streisand enjoying the sunset at Small Venice in Donna Karan's company.

Today, the windswept island seems to have redressed the balance and rediscovered its pace of life. Cycladic hospitality has found the way to keep in step with service of high standards, and Mykonos is now in a position to meet everyone's needs: the society people, the low profile ones, those who love reveling through the night, sport lovers, and family people. All the above is the proof that Mykonos accepts everything. It filters everything. The island has this magic little wand that manages to change you, even a little as happened with all the frequents that gradually became "slaves" to its eternal rythm. Mykonos is one of the most vivid examples of transformation. It can bring out the best or worst self, as some people who've lived it deeply have said. Maybe both. What difference does it make anyway?



As a new age is dawning for Minas, the experimentation with new forms and ideas is definitely something that excites. Particularly fun is visiting our cheese supplier where we get to sample where we get to sample cheeses at their early stages before maturation. I always enjoyed being close to animals and that connection helps build appreciation throughout the team for the beautiful produce we receive. My favourite ingredient are the mushrooms we pick around the Mettaleia area. It's a good old walk and the landscape is beautiful. A reminder of the somewhat hidden beauty of Mykonos.

O1. MEGALI AMMOS

Free of umbrellas and sun loungers, the beach is ideal for a quick dip for those who want to keep within a safe distance from Chora. Accessible even on foot, the golden beach with fine sand and northerly winds is also a great place for windsurfing, and a luxurious stay with high dining. Dive in the unique pool of Bill & Coo Suites & Lounge and taste the dishes of the restaurant (bill-coo-hotel.com).

O2. KAPARI

A western beach that is worth visiting late in the afternoon. A ten-minute walk from Agios Ioannis and you will arrive at one of the island's last havens. 03. AGIOS IDANNIS

Among the beach's strong points are the interesting seabed towards the right, ideal for snorkeling, the very fine pebbles that are perfect for natural reflexology and for barefoot luxury lovers. 04. ORNOS

The island's most popular family beach attracts all types of tourists, Greek families and quite a few locals. The natural barrier created by the settlement's houses blocks the strong north wind which often pounds the island, while the south wind does not affect the sea since the bay, while large, is closed and protected. Ornos' long sandy beach has numerous restaurants and café-bars with tables all the way to the sand.

O5. AGIOS STEFANOS

This is an ideal beach for those who wish to avoid high society, admire the magnificent views of the Small Delos islands and enjoy a magical sunset with the locals. If you

feel adventurous, keep driving towards the protected Houlakia beach. Swim to the small cove behind the rocky shoreline and benefit from this idyllic location despite the strong winds.

OG. HOULAKIA

A beautiful beach with golden sands and emerald waters, only 4 km north of the capital. It's a protected beach of natural beauty, divided in two parts. The left combines a small cove with a small beach. The right side is full of big, round multicoloured pebbles. Get ready to feel a sweet seclusion and a bit of "The Blue Lagoon" feeling.

07. RHENIA

The best way to visit Rhenia is by boat. Hidden caves and virgin beaches await those who get there. There are four unique and isolated beaches with golden-white sand and crystal-clear waters with blue-green colour on the island: Glyfada, Stena, Lia and Ambelia. Take a small beach hopping journey to admire them all.

OB. PSAROU

It has been experiencing glory days since the 1980s, setting the summer's trends and defining the concept of luxury living on Mykonos. It boasts warm waters even from the early spring. The road is quite narrow with sharp turns and requires attention. You will come here to see and be-seen. 09. PLATIS GIALOS

Protected from the winds and beautiful albeit packed, Platis Gialos is fairly developed. Its big plus is its sporty character and the plethora of restaurants and hotels that line the beach. The hotels, sunbeds and parasols usually attract families and young couples.

10. AGIA ANNA (PARAGA)

Agia Anna still maintains, to a degree, the image of a quiet, family beach, functioning as a discharging point from its two noisy neighbours. The beach faces southwest

and gets the sun until late, offering the opportunity for long-term sunbathing before or after enjoying the authentic recipes of Nikolas taverna (nikolas-taverna.com).

11. PARAGA

It is the first beach on the island to open and the last to close, since its favourable orientation guarantees warm days from May to October. 12. PARADISE

It is among the first of the island's hot spots to strongly support the nudist dogma. Numerous beach bars are lined on the beach, inspiring people to get up and dance. The beach is also accessible by sea on small boats (caiques) which depart from Ornos and Platis Gialos. The nights at Cavo Paradiso with a dazzling DJ line-up are unforgettable (cavoparadiso.gr).

13. SUPER PARADISE



Located above the dazzling turquoise waters of the beach, Jackie O' Beach Club awaits with an explosion of the senses (jackieomykonos. com), while the fresh Paraj Restaurant and Beach offers an exceptional high-end experience (paraj-superparadisemykonos.com).

14. AGIOS SOSTIS

No make-up, bars, shops, tourist enterprises or sunbeds. With wonderful deep blue waters, it favours snorkeling fans. Here you will see celebrities and anonymous nudists,

as well as locals. Best from May to mid-July and then in September; avoid the August meltemi winds which make conditions unwelcoming. You could go by your own vehicle or by taxi.

15. PANORMOS

The livelier beach of Mykonos remains a quiet corner. This ex-hippie and nudist haunt is reminiscent of old Mykonos, while it has a wild beauty with its colours changing throughout the day. Choose Panormos if you want a break from the large crowds and enjoy a truly magical scenery.

16. FTELIA

Ftelia is divided into two by a rock formation that reaches the sea. Starting from Chora, take a right turn at the crossroads to discover the ideal surfing destination and admire a performance offered by the virtuoso surfers. When it is not windy, the

landscape is reminiscent of a lagoon and the beach is frequented by a number of locals and artists.

17. FOKOS & MYRSINI

Fokos still remains an untouched treasure, as buses don't reach this beach, with shallow green water and thick sand. Picturesque and calm with the island's coldest waters, it is located right after the artificial lake of Marathi and is quite seriously affected by the north winds. Myrsini is the next beach with crystal-clear green waters. Another small, sandy gem that calms you, with its natural tranquillity and its blue horizon.

18. ELIA

A lot of people prefer Elia as the best beach on the island, ideal for water sports and for families. You must visit to discover it for yourself! Do not forget that it is one of the

bigger sandy beaches on the island and that it preserves its bohemian feeling. It is better to visit it on days with a north wind for calm waters.

19. AGRARI

On the south side of the island, Agrari introduces its charm and calmness. It has sun loungers and water sports and can also be accessed by small boats from Platis Gialos. The beach's right-hand side, by the rocks, is ideal for diving and playing games in the clear blue water. Taste local appetizers and share traditional recipes at noon at Agrari Beach Restaurant (agraribeach.gr).

20. KALO LIVADI

In the southern eastern part of the island, you will find one of the best organized beaches with a strong cosmopolitan feel, which covers every entertainment and taste expectation. Indulge in this long, yellow sandy beach with green-blue clear waters, abundant umbrellas, sunbeds and water sports.

21. AGIA ANNA (KALAFATIS)

22. KALAFATIS


Super Paradise
